

When did One World Secondary School start? How long did Pre-Form I stay?

The school started in October 2012. They stayed for 2 month.

This school is going until what level? It is going until form 6.

Is One World Secondary School a UNESCO school?

Yes, it is among the UNESCO schools. Three months ago, I submitted our application to the Secretary General of the Tanzanian Commission for UNESCO and she said, "It is OK."

What does UNESCO deal with?

UNESCO deals with education, science, culture, and information all around the world.

What do you prefer, a boarding school or a day school?

I prefer a boarding school. Why? Because in a boarding school you can work together with your fellow student, even after the lessons.

What about to hire permanent teachers?

Now I have hired two permanent teachers, but I'm still searching for other excellent teachers.

Are all teachers going to be Tanzanian teachers?

No, there will be also some German teachers.



Are we going to do the NECTA and German exam also?

Yes, we will do both in Form 4. In form 2 you only do the NECTA exams. After Form 6 there is planned NECTA F6 and International Baccalaureate.

Is there also a pre-form one this year? And when are they coming?

Yes, there is. They are coming on October 14^{th} .


Are there going to be exchange programs?
